

Dr. Heather Basehore is a Health Science Administrator in the Office of Data Sharing at the National Cancer Institute. Her work supports implementation of NIH data sharing policies, with particular focus on high-visibility programs like the Childhood Cancer Data Initiative. She earned her Ph.D. in biochemistry from Penn State and her research has spanned molecular biology, genetics, and behavioral health.
